Requirements

Applicants must hold a doctoral degree (mathematics, statistics, computer science, physics or related fields will be specially valued). The PhD thesis defense of the candidate must be after January 1st, 2015. Applications will also be accepted from candidates who are expected to obtain a PhD degree by October 31, 2023.

Candidates must have obtained their doctoral thesis from a university other than the University of Granada, or have spent the last academic year outside of Granada at the moment of application.

The applicant's CV must reflect a promising research career, with good interpersonal skills; ability to work independently as well as in a collaborative research team; excellent skills to communicate research outcomes in written and spoken form. It will be especially valuable the intention of applying to international research funding calls (ERC and similar ones).

How to apply

Applications must be digitally registered at the electronic office of the University of Granada, in the procedure: "Investigación: Contratos con cargo a Grupos, Proyectos y Convenios", which will be available soon online. This procedure will be mandatory for all persons in possession of a Spanish DNI/NIE.

As an exception, for persons who do not have a DNI/NIE, they may authorize a third person in the established form, for the submission on their behalf of the application through the electronic headquarters of the University of Granada. In this sense, in case the applicant wishes the IMAG staff to register his/her application at the web site above, he/she shall send no later than April 13 2023, the signed authorization document (see last page) to that effect to the e-mail address imag@ugr.es, indicating in the subject field the reference "IMAG2023- Postdoctoral fellowships", together with the documentation specified below.

Full CV, in free format, including a complete publication list and ORCID identifier.

PhD accreditation, or failing that, a document justifying that the defense of the doctoral thesis will take place before October 31, 2023.

Title and brief description of the research project, including reasons for carrying it out at Granada, in free format (max. 2 pages).







Two reference letters. Candidates should arrange for these letters to be sent directly to imag@ugr.es by the persons who will provide the references (not by the applicant). Reference letters will be accepted until April 30, 2023.
